

House Rules Badminton Association Erasmus – Version September 2025

Welcome to BVE!

At BVE, we want everyone to enjoy playing sports in a safe and pleasant environment. By respecting our house rules, we can make this possible together:

General

- 1. Only members of BVE are allowed to participate in training sessions and free play.
- 2. It is not possible to purchase or use a day pass to access BVE training sessions or free play.
- 3. It is strictly forbidden to lend your membership card or pass to others.

Clothing and Equipment

- 4. Proper sportswear and indoor shoes must be worn at all times, in accordance with the house rules of Erasmus Sport. Outdoor shoes and shoes that leave marks on the floor are not permitted.
- 5. During free play, all members are expected to bring their own racket and shuttles.
 - Shuttles are provided by BVE during training sessions.
 - If a member does not own a racket, one can be rented at the service desk for €2 per session.

Behavior and Respect

- 6. Everyone must treat each other with respect, regardless of religion, culture, gender, or background.
- 7. As a guest of the Sports Building, you are expected to help keep the facilities clean and in good condition, in line with the house rules of Erasmus Sport.

Free Play

- 8. During During free play, it is not permitted to occupy a court for extended periods when it is busy.
 - Playing a match is of course allowed, but once the match is finished, the court must be made available to members waiting on the sidelines.
 - If no one is waiting and other courts are still available, you may start a new match right away.
- 9. When it is busy and members are waiting on the sidelines, singles matches are not allowed. In such cases, doubles should be played so that as many members as possible can participate at the same time.
- 10. When it is busy and members are waiting, a maximum of two sets may be played per match. A third set is not allowed in such cases, to ensure that everyone gets a fair chance to play.
